Dear Friend,

When raising children, we must be future focused. Psalm 78:4 says, "...We will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, His power, and the wonders He has done." It continues that our spiritual heritage is rich because for generations, parents have taught children of the works of God.

Verses 6 and 7 continue, "so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children. Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep His commands."

To ensure the best future for the children in our care, we want them to be in a secure and loving family. Our next step at providing for their future is through education. The children in our care have so many opportunities to learn and thrive in adulthood:

- In Liberia, we have the Hope Student Center for our children to use for attending college.
- In Myanmar, we have the Elim Farm where the children can learn to grow crops and care for livestock. We also have our sewing machines, and the children can learn tailoring skills as a trade.
- In Zambia, our new children are enrolled, for the first time, in school. Imagine what this means for their future!
- In India, we partner with Agape Royal Ministries and Logos College. The children in the group homes often attend Logos, and sometimes become houseparents when they are adults.
- We are currently serving in 8 countries, and we are committed to investing in all our children's futures through education.

Our goal is for each child to have 2 new school uniforms and supplies. Will you consider adding the future of a child's education to your shopping list this year? Your gift will help cover the cost of uniforms, supplies, and their daily care.

Augustin lives in our home in the Dominican Republic. Augustin loves going to school and church. He would like to be a master in teaching and be a pastor



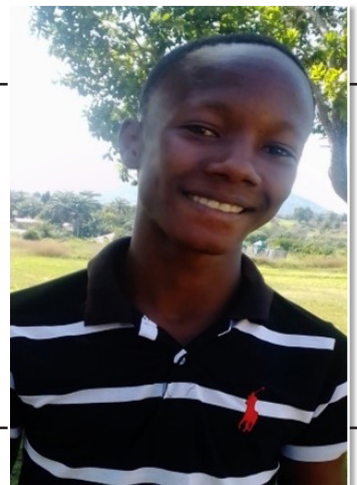
Hriimatsi | 12 Years Old | India

In 2021 we opened homes for children in Zambia, Dominican Republic and Haiti. This is an exciting time for the mission of BCH because, for many of our children in these countries this new school year will be their first ever. Considering the devastating poverty rates and low school enrollment, your gift will help break the cycle of helplessness. Please use the enclosed donation slip and postage paid envelope to help us reach our goal to equip over 700 children with uniforms and the supplies needed to attend school.

This year, will you give to help cover the costs of our children attending school? For many, they will need uniforms, school supplies, and tuition costs. Our average cost of a school uniform is \$25, and I am sure you

understand the need for more than one per child! While our families utilize "hand-me-downs", these uniforms get a significant amount of use through the year.
