What started as Joseph's hope to build a farm has become more than we could have imagined. Friends sent funds to purchase the land, start crops, build a home, and start raising livestock.

The Elim Farm is a haven during Myanmar's political coup, and it is also a picture of God's providence. Joseph and his team are teaching children to grow their own produce, raise pigs for food and profit, fish in the stocked pond, and learn skills to live a self-sustained life. During the threat of a military coup, Covid, and the rainy season, the Elim Farm is a special place of solace and safety for the children in BCH's care in the country of Myanmar.

Currently, Joseph and his team have been building structures and caring for their crops and livestock using a borrowed



truck. Recently the use of this truck is no longer an option. Transporting brick, feed and harvested crops by foot is very tasking. We are asking for your help to purchase a new truck!

Our 2022 VBS Project offers an opportunity for your church to personally connect with a mission to directly help children across the globe. This project can expand their horizons and can be easily understood by children.
